Los Angeles County Department of Public Health Updates



Reopening Protocols for TK - 12 Schools as of July 28, 2021

LA County Department of Public Health

- All schools are permitted to reopen for all students in grades TK - 12
- All schools must have a COVID-19 Compliance Team
- All schools must have a School Exposure Management Plan
- A plan to incorporate COVID-19 Testing into regular school operations
- Daily Employee and Student Screenings
- Masking is required for anyone entering a school building or school buses
- All Staff must wear a face covering at all times when indoors

LA County Department of Public Health

Accommodations for Students who cannot use or tolerate a face mask:

- *Appropriate documentation demonstrating a disability or condition that does not allow them to safely wear a mask should wear a face shield with drape at the bottom*
- *Students exempted from wearing a mask indoors are to be tested for COVID-19 at least 2xs a week*
- *Students will be offered an alternative educational opportunity*



School Site Exposure Management Plan (EMP)

- COVID-19 Compliance Officer & School TEAM
- Confirmed COVID-19 Case required to follow Home Isolation Instructions
- Department of Public Health (DPH) is informed & Isolation Order submitted
- School Team works to identify ALL individuals who have had exposure
- Notification is provided to ALL exposed via a letter or phone call
- Exposed students and employees must self-quarantine and monitor for 14 days from last day of contact
- DPH will contact exposed students and employees
- School Team will determine if additional notification is needed to the wider school community

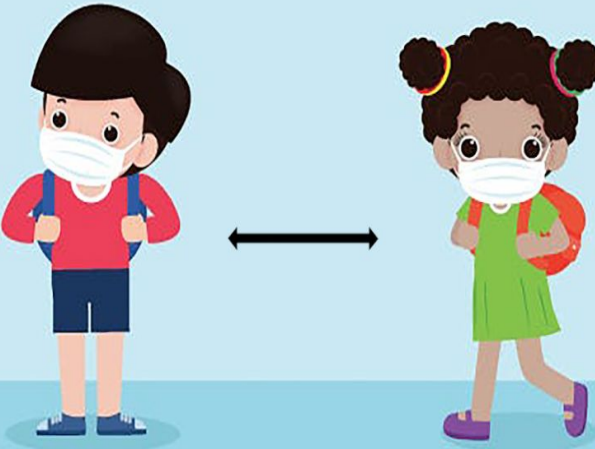

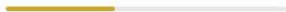

Children sent home who exhibit symptoms . . .

- Recommended that child gets COVID-19 tested
- Isolate child from other family members
- Required to isolate your child at home for 10 days
- Receive a call from the School Nurse
- Your child is allowed to return if:
 - Medical Doctor's note confirming your child does not have symptoms consistent with COVID-19
 - Tests negative for COVID-19
 - Doctor's note will be required upon return to school

Study Program***



Independent Study (IS)

- Optional Instructional Strategy. It is NOT distance learning.
- Special Education students need to have an IEP meeting before enrolling in Independent Studies
- Students whose health or other personal circumstances make classroom attendance difficult
- Short-term basis and Voluntary
- There must be a signed written agreement for the child to participate in IS no later than 30 days after the first day of instruction.
- Agreement constitutes permission for the student to receive academic instruction through independent study.

Independent Study (IS) cont.

- Assigned a teacher
- Students are provided with content aligned to grade level standards
- Grades TK through 5th Grade
 - Opportunities for daily synchronous instruction

Independent Study (IS) cont.

- Students who do not attend daily shall be documented as non-participatory for that school day
- After 3 missed assignments an evaluation will be conducted if appropriate to remain in the program
- A plan to transition students who wish to return to in-person instruction is necessary when students have participated in an independent study program
- Parent-educator conference prior to disenrollment from independent study

MUSD Elementary Schools

- Will follow the 2021-22 School Calendar
- Daily Attendance: Monday - Friday
- 305 Instructional Minutes Daily
- Class Size for Elementary
 - TK - Kindergarten - 20:1
 - Grades 1st - 3rd - 22:1
 - Grades 4th - 5th - 29:1

Classroom Safety

- Classrooms will be cleaned daily after dismissal
- Restrooms will be cleaned throughout the day
- Outdoor patio area will be monitored and cleaned daily
- Each classroom will have hand sanitizer, PPE equipment, air purifier, and wipes
- Each student will have a desk buddy



Recess and Lunch

- Social distancing encouraged
- Students will go out to recess and lunch
- No face coverings required outdoors
- Meals will be served to all students in the cafeteria

Student Pick up Procedures

Parents may not come on campus to pick up students. Students will be released as follows:

Gate 1 (Kindergarten playground): TK and Kindergarten students only

Gate 2: all students

Main Office Gate: all students

Cafeteria Gate: all students

Florence Gate: all students may exit. **Note:** Kindergarten and 1st grade students that exit through this gate will be escorted by a staff member at 1:55pm.

2021- 2022 INFORMATION

First Day of School: Monday, August 16, 2021

Suva Street Gates Open: 7:30 a.m.

Florence Place Gate will not be open in the mornings.

Daily Schedule: 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

The following procedures are aligned with the most recent County of Los Angeles Health Office guidelines to ensure the safety of all students, staff, and community members.

Student Drop Off

Florence Place gate will not be open in the mornings. All students must enter through one of the following *three* gates on Suva Street:

Suva Elementary Information

Only Suva Elementary students and staff will be allowed to enter the campus. We will have support staff at the gates ready to escort any child needing assistance.

Daily symptom check: students will be required to complete the daily symptom check prior to arrival at school. Students also need to show proof at the gate that **they are eligible to be at school (green check mark)**.

Please observe all traffic rules including no u turns, double parking, asking students to cross Suva Street, etc. The safety of every student is our priority. Please be patient and leave home early since our new safety protocols will be time consuming.

Gate 1 (Kindergarten playground): TK and Kindergarten only **Gate 2:** 1st grade only

Main Office Gate: 2nd and 3rd grade only

Cafeteria Gate: 3rd through 5th grade only
